

CASE FOR SUPPORT

- The proposed North Conway Recreation and Alternative Transportation Path, a non-motorized, entry level, multi-purpose recreation path, is an amenity long overdue for our community.
- A dedicated group of community minded citizens have been working toward this goal since 1971.
- A wide range of concepts and routes have been vetted through communicating with the public, potential funders, local, state and federal government.
- The 2.8-mile route can be accessed from Hemlock Lane at the entrance to the Redstone Quarry, the Thompson Road trailhead, and Cranmore Mountain Fitness Center. Each location is less than a mile from Route 16 and has public parking.
- The North Conway Recreation and Alternative Transportation Path, will provide access to trails near Pudding Pond and Green Hills Preserve, as well as access to schools, shopping, pharmacies, dentists, businesses and human services, etc.
- This path will advance our community's desire to:
 - Promote a healthy outdoor lifestyle
 - Enjoy the natural beauty of our region
 - Reduce air quality emissions
 - Mitigate traffic congestion
- The path is designed to be wide enough for walkers, hikers, joggers, wheelchairs, cyclists, roller bladers, cross country skiers, snowshoers, strollers, etc.
- Funding for building and maintaining the path will be provided by a community wide capital campaign and grants with a goal of \$2.3 million, which includes an endowment for maintenance.

WHAT IS THE MOUNT WASHINGTON VALLEY TRAILS ASSOCIATION?

Formed in 2006 as a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization currently governed by a volunteer board of directors comprised of local residents.

WHY DID YOU CHOOSE THE NORTH CONWAY PATH LOCATION?

It was chosen because of its central location paralleling the North-South Road, generally flat terrain, sensitivities to other users and conservation groups, trail heads with ample parking and the availability of a contiguous corridor.

WHY PAVEMENT?

This is the best surface for an entry level path that people of all ages and abilities can use safely and confidently. It will be ADA compliant and assist with encouraging its use instead of an automobile.

WHAT IS THE SCHEDULE FOR PATH CONSTRUCTION?

We are hoping to break ground in May of 2018 with completion in 2019 for the summer season

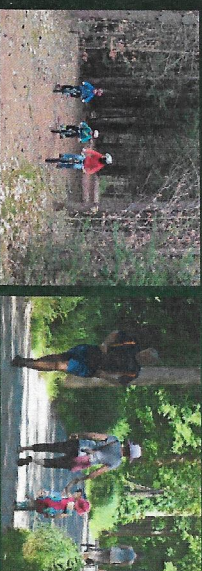
Introducing

TRAILS ASSOCIATION

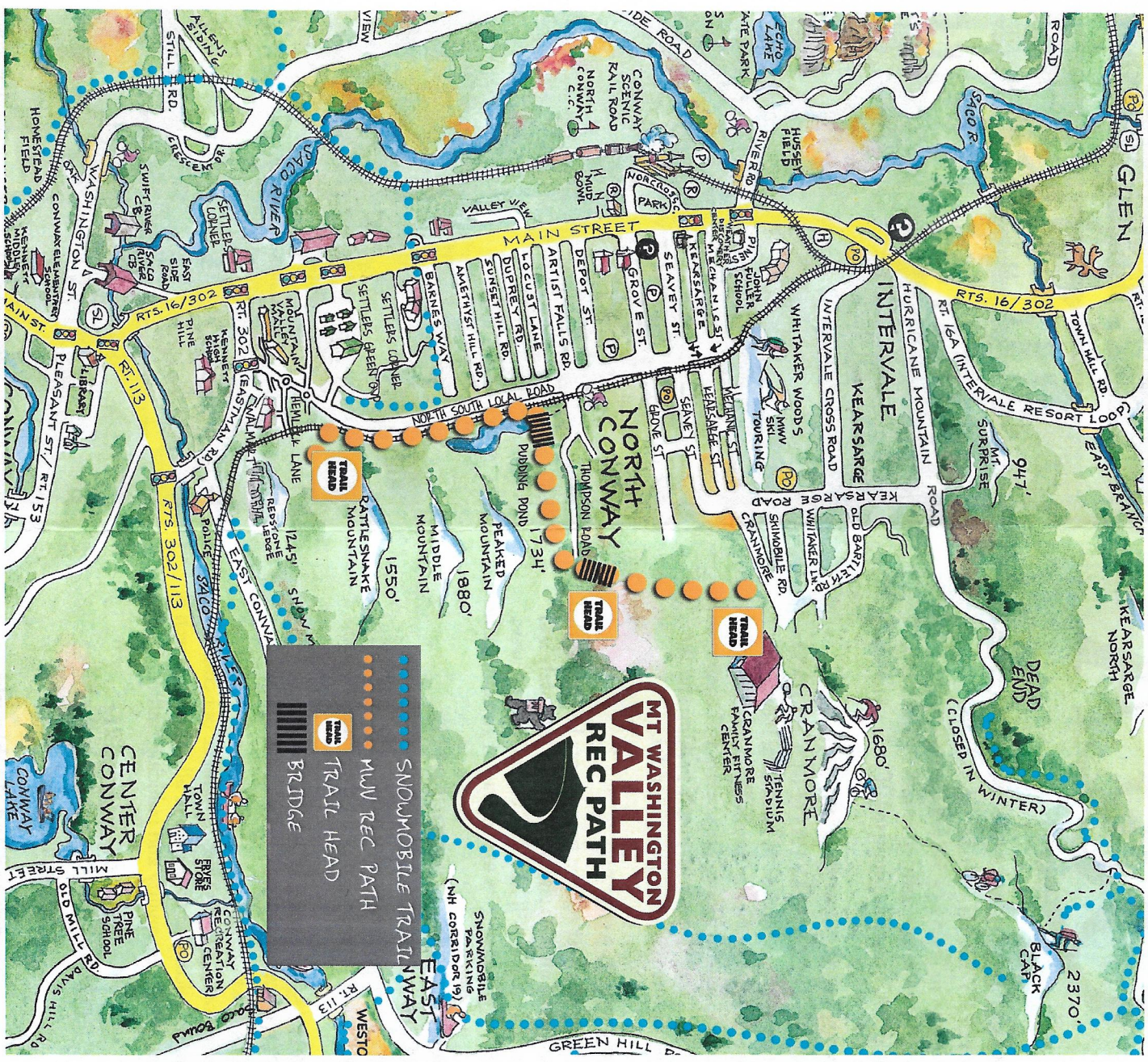
