We have been advised that Pope Security will be on-site next week to begin the process of changing out the expired CO detectors in all units, which includes changing the wiring to each of these devices. Access into EVERY unit is mandatory to complete this most necessary project. Steve Richardson will be accompanying the crew from Pope Security.

You should also be advised that access into ALL of the units will be needed again after the CO project is concluded, in order to test the entire alarm system to make sure it is functioning properly.

If you have someone staying in your unit, you should advise them of the impending work to be done; and if you have changed the locks on your entry door so the master key to all units does not open your entry door, it is YOUR responsibility to contact Steve Richardson directly to coordinate the access into your unit while Pope Security is on-site.
